

Tennis Northern Beaches District Championships

Competition Conditions of Entry

1. Rules:

- a. The TNB District Championships will be conducted in accordance with the TNB Junior Development Committee. The competition committee shall have the entire control and management of the events and their decision in any dispute shall be final.
- b. The championships will be conducted under the rules of tennis as approved by the rules and regulations of Tennis Australia.

2. Tennis NSW: All players must be registered with Tennis NSW or can pay for membership by using the form available on www.tennisnsw.com.au.

3. Entry Fees: Must accompany all entries by the closing date. Entries will not be accepted without fees.

4. Events: Players may only enter one event. To qualify for the District Championship finals a player must compete in at least 2 of the 3 championship rounds.

5. Age Eligibility: Entries are open to players who are of or under the age for their respective events at midnight 30th November 2016.

6. Seeding and player ability:

- a. The competitions organiser will determine seeding based on previous TNB competitions where possible, and the information provided by the player
- b. Organisers/supervisors may assist in the scoring of all matches

7. Matches:

- a. All events will be a round robin format. Numbers in each pool will be dependant on the number of entries.

8. Withdrawals: Players who withdraw or don't show up at the event will forfeit their entry fee unless a medical certificate is provided.

9. Attire: Correct tennis attire must be worn in all events.

10. Umpiring: Any player may be required to umpire at the direction of the organisers of the event.

11. Be Ready to Play:

- a. All players should arrive ready to play and be signed in 20mins prior to the event starting
- b. players should have a hat, sunscreen
- c. in case of inclement weather, activities will be conducted. If play has not commenced after an hour of starting time a decision will be made whether the event will be postponed.

12. Privacy Statement:

- a. Photographs and results maybe used to promote the events for publicity purposes, without compensation
- b. Please inform Tennis Northern Beaches, event organisers, before the matches commence if you do not want your child's' photo published.

13. Adjustments:

- a. The organisers of the event reserve the right to reduce, or re-schedule any matches due to extenuating circumstances
- b. In the case of inclement weather, the event will be not be replayed.

14. Code of Conduct: the code of conduct as approved by Tennis Australia will be enforced during this tournament. A copy of this code of conduct will be displayed in the Tournament Office. It is the responsibility of each player (and parent/supervisor) to familiarise themselves with the code of conduct.
